## 12 principles of the Agile Manifesto

<i>Nr.</i>	<i>Principle</i>
1	<b>Rapid Delivery</b> Customer satisfaction by rapid delivery of useful software.
2	<b>Welcome changes</b> Welcome changing requirements, even late in development.
3	<b>Frequent delivery</b> Working software is delivered frequently (weeks rather than months).
4	<b>Measure of progress</b> Working software is the principal measure of progress.
5	<b>Sustainable Development</b> Sustainable development, able to maintain a constant pace.
6	<b>Daily cooperation</b> Close, daily cooperation between business people and developers.
7	<b>Face-to-face communication</b> Face-to-face conversation is the best form of communication (co-location).
8	<b>Motivated, trusted individuals</b> Projects (?) are built around motivated individuals, who should be trusted.
9	<b>Attention to excellence and design</b> Continuous attention to technical excellence and good design.
10	<b>Simplicity</b> Simplicity is essential.
11	<b>Self-organizing</b> Self-organizing teams.
12	<b>Regular adaptation</b> Regular adaptation to changing circumstances
